Appendix 1 Definitions

For questions 4, 5 and 6: electronic communications service

Electronic communications service means a service normally provided for remuneration which consists wholly or mainly in the conveyance of signals on electronic communications networks, including telecommunications services and transmission services in networks used for broadcasting, but exclude services providing, or exercising editorial control over, content transmitted using electronic communications networks and services, as defined in Article 1 of Directive 98/34/EC, which do not consist wholly or mainly in the conveyance of signals on electronic communications networks;

For questions 4, 5 and 6: 'mobile' as compared to 'fixed'

Fixed is understood to mean: those services that the user accesses from a fixed position, although relocation of that position is imaginable (e.g. wireless fidelity [Wifi], asymmetric digital subscriber line [ADSL]) and irrespective of whether the connection is fixed or wireless (e.g. wireless local loop [WLL]). Mobile means: everything that does not satisfy the description of fixed.

For questions 7, 8 and 9: electronic communications network

Electronic communications network means transmission systems and, where applicable, switching or routing equipment and other resources which permit the conveyance of signals by wire, by radio, by optical or by other electromagnetic means, including satellite networks, fixed (circuit- and packet-switched, including Internet) and mobile terrestrial networks, electricity cable systems, to the extent that they are used for the purpose of transmitting signals, networks used for radio and television broadcasting, and cable television networks, irrespective of the type of information conveyed;

Public electronic communications network

Public communications network means an electronic communications network used wholly or mainly for the provision of publicly available electronic communications services;

Provision of a network

Provision of an electronic communications network means the establishment, operation, control or making available of such a network;

Based on the definition of electronic communications network, nearly every provider of a public electronic communications service is also provider of a public electronic network because he uses transmission systems, including switching and routing equipment, for the supply of the public electronic communications service.

Providers of public electronic communications services who do not believe that they also provide a public electronic network must indicate and explain this. In general, only the providers (re-sellers) of services provided by others, who enter into contracts with buyers in their own name, will be considered providers of public electronic communications services without their own electronic communications network. The provider is the party that controls the allowing of services on the network and the management thereof; thus this does not consider who the owner is.

For question 11: Relevant facilities

Relevant facilities means those facilities relevant with an electronic communications network and/or an electronic communication service which enable and/or support the provision of services via that network and/or service. It includes conditional access systems and electronic programme guides.

OPTA assumes that relevant facilities, with the exception of systems for conditional access, will in general be provided by those who provide an electronic communications service or network.
